Spring Cleaning



Cleaning out your garage, kitchen, bedroom or closets? Residents of single-family homes are entitled to 2 free On-Call Cleanups between January 1 and December 31 of each year. We will collect up to 12 bags of garbage, OR 6 bags of garbage and 1 large item. The large item can be a sofa, mattress, appliance or similar. Special handling fees do apply to some electronics. An appointment is required and must be made at least one business day in advance.

- Call us at 650.589.4020 to make an appointment.
- Tell us what you will be placing at the curb for collection.
- Contain garbage in bags or boxes.
