- ✓ Put used batteries and cell phones inside the enclosed sample bag or any clear zip-top bag and seal.
- On your regular collection day, place full bag on top of the lid to your gray Garbage cart.

## **What's Accepted:**

- **AA, AAA, C, D, 9-volt** and **button batteries** are all accepted through this program.
