## **Got HHW?**



## Keduce the negative impacts of household hazardous waste (HHW) by following these tips:

- Choose less toxic alternatives when possible. Visit <u>www.smchealth.org/hhw</u> for a list.
- > Buy only what you need.
- Give away hazardous products you cannot use, or dispose of them properly.
  - We provide curbside collection of household batteries, motor oil and filters on your regular collection day. Batteries and oil filters must be sealed in clear plastic bags. Please place clear tape over the terminals of all 9 volt and lithium batteries. Battery bags should be placed on top of the lid to your gray garbage cart for collection. Filter bags belong under the blue lid of your recycling cart. Motor oil must be in a sturdy, labeled container with a secure screw-on lid. Containers should be placed at the curb next to your recycling cart.
  - San Mateo County hosts free HHW drop-off events. Visit <u>www.smchealth.org/hhw</u> or call 650.363.4718 for days, times, locations, and a list of acceptable items. An appointment is required.
  - Up to 10 gallons of latex and oil base paint in original containers with labels can be dropped off for no charge at any location listed on <u>PaintCare.org</u>.
  - Fluorescent bulbs and tubes can be dropped off at select home improvement stores. Check with your favorite retailer to see if they have a take-back program or use the search engine at <u>www.recyclestuff.org</u>.
  - Automotive batteries, motor oil & filters, paint, antifreeze and sharps can be dropped off at Blue Line Transfer at no charge to residential customers. Cooking oil, household batteries, fluorescent bulbs and tubes are also accepted but fees apply. Visit <u>www.ssfscavenger.com/transfer-station</u> for hours and additional information.
