- ◆ Blue Line Transfer is open Monday-Friday from 6 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and on Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Face coverings and social distancing are required. The CRV Buyback, E-Waste, and BOPA (batteries, motor oil/filters, paint, antifreeze) facilities are OPEN. Buyback hours are Monday-Friday from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Saturday from 8 a.m. to noon.

- Making sure your carts are not overloaded and lids are fully closed.

- ◆ Storing your carts out of view from the street on non-collection days.

Blue "SPLIT" Cart

Put your recyclables in the blue cart. Clean, dry paper products belong under the gray lid. Other accepted recyclables belong under the blue lid.



Green Cart

Put your food scraps, food-soiled paper and yard trimmings in the green cart.
