Holiday Collection Schedule

Fall 2020

Christmas Day and New Year's Day fall on FRIDAY this year.
For these two days only, collection services will be rescheduled so that our employees may spend the holidays with their families. This change ONLY affects customers who usually receive service on FRIDAY.

Friday customers will have collection services on Saturday, December 26, and Saturday, January 2, instead of on Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Notice of this change will also be sent by mail. There is no change for customers who usually have collection service on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday. Regular Friday collection resumes on January 8.

Plan Ahead to Prevent Holiday Waste!

More waste is created between Thanksgiving and New Year's than any other time of year. You can do your part to reduce unnecessary waste by planning ahead. Follow these tips:

- 1. Send electronic greetings. Or, if you enjoy sending traditional cards, make sure they are made from recycled content and can be recycled again.
- **2.** Shop locally to avoid the excess packaging used by online retailers. Remember to bring reusable shopping bags.
- 3. Give gifts that are durable or consumable and won't end up in the landfill
- **4.** Avoid single–use gift wrap, bags and ribbon—especially those that are not recyclable. Choose reusable alternatives.
- **5.** Set your holiday table with reusable plates, cups, napkins and silverware.

Please Recycle Your Christmas Tree

Remove the stand and all decorations including lights and tinsel.

- **)** Cut tree in half if it is over 6 feet.
- ▶ Place tree at the curb by 5 a.m. on your regular collection day.
- **>** Do not bag your tree.

A special truck may be used to collect trees in your neighborhood. This truck can arrive earlier or later than our regular trucks. Note that flocked and artificial trees cannot be recycled and will be collected by the regular garbage route.



Deep Frying a Turkey?

Let the cooking oil cool, pour into one gallon jugs, and bring to Blue Line Transfer. Fees apply and there is a 10-gallon limit. Small amounts of solidified fat, oil and grease can be scrapped into your green organics cart. We recommend wrapping in newspaper or a paper towel first.

Invite your Organics cart to this year's holiday feasts!

Your **green** cart is hungry for corn cobs, soggy yams and potato peels.

It even craves turkey bones and dried out stuffing.

Please feed food scraps directly to your cart. Liner bags are not allowed.



Seasonal Overflow?

Please do not overload any of your carts. Make sure the lids fully close and materials are not too tightly wedged inside. This will help prevent litter and ensure your carts are completely emptied.

If you have overflow, follow the instructions below.

Extra Garbage

Overflow garbage can be bagged, set next to your garbage cart, and collected on your regular collection day. Please contact us at 650.589.4020 at least one business day in advance. You can choose to use an On–Call Cleanup or pay the extra bag fee.

Extra Recycling

Overflow recyclables can be collected curbside for no charge. Place clean, dry paper and empty containers (aluminum/metal, glass and plastic bottles, jars, cans, tubs) in separate paper bags and leave next to your recycling cart on your regular collection day. Remember that cardboard boxes should be flattened, bundled, and left beside your recycling cart as well.
