Happy Holidays from South San Francisco Scavenger Company! Please remember:

Collection service is provided as usual during the week of Thanksgiving.

Our offices and Blue Line
Transfer close at noon on
Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve and New
Year's Eve.

Our offices and Blue Line Transfer are closed and collection service is not provided on Christmas Day or New Year's Day – services are automatically rescheduled.

Blue Line Transfer is open with regular Saturday hours on December 26 and January 2.

WE RECYCLE CHRISTMAS TREES

- Remove stands and all decorations including lights and tinsel.
- Cut trees in half if taller than 6 feet.
- Do not bag or tie trees.
- Place trees near your garbage and recycling carts/bins for collection.
- Contact us to schedule collection. Trees are collected from multifamily residential properties at no charge. A \$10-\$20 fee is charged per tree (depending on size) collected from a business.

Resolutions for 2021

- ✓ **Sort waste correctly.** Contaminated recyclables may not be collected. Take the time to learn what is and is not recyclable. Contact us if you have questions: email us at info@ssfscavenger.com, call us at 650.589.4020, or use the new "Sort Smart" tool at ssfscavenger.com.
- Make sure your waste containers are the right size. Lids must close completely. Contact us to increase service or request a special collection of occasional overflow.
- Keep waste containers closed at all times. This will eliminate wind-blown litter and prevent containers from becoming a breeding place for insects and critters.
- Comply with California Law. Assembly Bill 341 requires all businesses and multifamily residential complexes with 5 or more living units to separate recyclable materials from their garbage. Assembly Bill 1826 requires that all businesses generating 2 cubic yards or more of waste per week implement an organics recycling program. [Note that in September, the threshold was reduced from 4 cubic yards to 2.] Assembly Bill 827 requires front-of-house organic waste collection bins in all restaurants and cafeterias where patrons clear their own tables.
