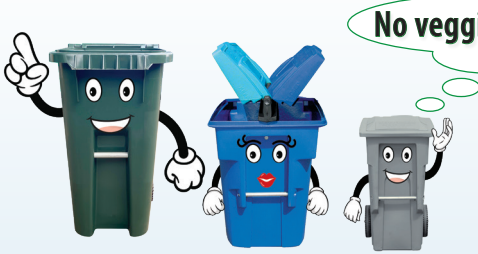

WHAT YOU FEED YOUR CARTS IS IMPORTANT

Please do NOT feed HHW to your carts.



Reduce the negative impacts of household hazardous waste (HHW) by following these tips:

- Choose less toxic alternatives when possible. Visit smchealth.org/safercleaning for a list.
- Buy only what you need.
- Give away hazardous products you cannot use, or dispose of them properly.
 - ◆ Place used household batteries and cell phones together in a clear zip-top bag, seal, and put on top of the lid to your **GARBAGE** cart. Please put clear tape over both ends of each used lithium and 9 volt battery and wrap cell phones in paper.
 - ◆ Place used motor oil and filters next to your **RECYCLING** cart. Contain used motor oil in original or other labeled jug with screw-top lid. Jugs must be 1-gallon or smaller. Contain used oil filters in clear zip-top bag. Limit of 5 gallons of oil and 5 filters per collection day.
 - ◆ Take HHW to a free drop-off event hosted by San Mateo County. Visit smchealth.org/hhw or call 650.363.4718 for days, times, locations, and a list of acceptable items. An appointment is required.
 - ◆ Drop-off up to 10 gallons of latex or oil-based paint for no charge at any location listed on PaintCare.org. Paint must be in original containers with labels.
 - ◆ Bring automotive batteries, motor oil & filters, paint, antifreeze and sharps to Blue Line Transfer. There is no disposal charge for residential customers. Cooking oil, household batteries, fluorescent bulbs and tubes are also accepted but fees apply. Visit bluelinetransfer.com for hours and additional information.

SPRING CLEANING?

Residents of single-family homes are entitled to 2 free On-Call Cleanups per calendar year. We will collect up to 12 bags of garbage, **or** 6 bags of garbage and 1 large item, **or** 2 large items. A large item can be a sofa, mattress, appliance or similar. Special handling fees apply to some electronics. Cleanups are scheduled to occur on your regular collection day. An appointment is required and must be made at least one business day in advance.

- Tell us what you will be placing at the curb for collection.
- Contain garbage and any small items in bags or boxes.
