

Please Keep It Clean:

Do not contaminate recyclables. Scrape and rinse food and beverage containers before placing under the dark blue lid of your recycling cart. Only put clean, dry paper under the lighter colored lid (grey or light blue). Flatten boxes first. Remember that our trucks have two compartments and they keep your carefully sorted paper items separate from containers.

Use extreme caution with ash! Let cool for several hours and then scoop fireplace, stove and barbecue ash into a metal container with tight fitting lid. Put the container outdoors and 10 feet or more away from structures and combustibles. If needed, add water to speed the cooling process. Once totally cool, place ash in garbage. Be sure to bag or box it first to prevent a messy spill during collection.



Keep all cart lids completely closed. This will help keep critters and rain out—preventing potential messes and keeping recyclable paper items dry. Contact us to arrange for the collection of overflow. Overloaded carts may automatically incur extra fees.

Put all your carts away after they have been emptied. Your city requires that carts be rolled out no more than 12 hours before service and stored out of sight from the street no more than 12 hours after.

Correct Sorting Required

State law (SB 1383) and local ordinance require that organic waste be sorted from landfill-bound garbage. To avoid service delays, extra fees and citations:

1. Place food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard trimmings in your green cart.
2. Place clean/dry paper in the correct side of your blue cart.
3. Be careful not to contaminate the materials in your green and blue carts with items that do not belong.

PLEASE RECYCLE HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES & CELL PHONES

When not properly disposed, batteries can cause fires. Please recycle them safely. Place used household batteries and cell phones together in a clear zip-top bag, seal, and put on top of the lid to your grey garbage cart. Leaky batteries are okay – be sure to handle with care. Please put clear tape over the terminals of each used lithium and 9 volt battery and wrap cell phones in paper.

Automotive and other large batteries, as well as tools and appliances with nonremovable batteries require special handling. They can be taken to Blue Line Transfer. Fees may apply. Please contact us at 650.589.4020 or info@ssfscavenger.com for more information.



REPLACING YOUR SMOKE OR CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTOR?

Please dispose of old detectors responsibly. Review labels and manufacturer websites for warnings and disposal instructions.

Ionization smoke detectors emit small amounts of radioactive material. They can be identified by their warning labels. These cannot be placed in any of your collection carts. Return these to the manufacturer by mail. Scan this QR



code for a list of manufacturers and instructions.

Photoelectric detectors will not have a warning label. Please remove and recycle any batteries. The detector can then be recycled as e-waste. SSF Scavenger can collect via the On-Call Cleanup Program, or you can bring to Blue Line Transfer (fees apply).
