

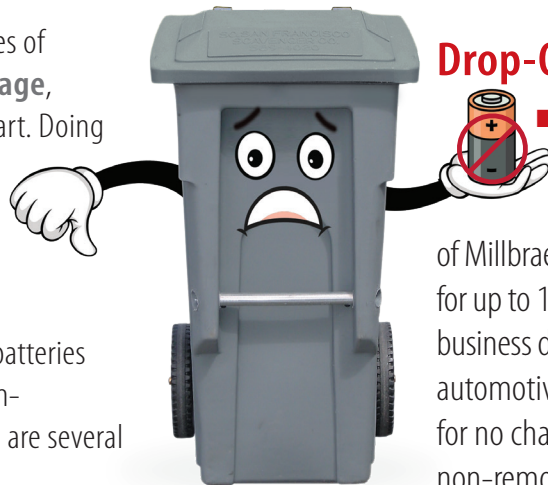
Batteries Can Start Fires

Please **do not** put batteries of any kind inside your **garbage**, **recycling**, or **organics** cart. Doing so can result in fires and explosions that may injure people and damage equipment.

You can safely dispose of batteries and items that contain non-removable batteries. There are several relatively easy options:

Curbside Collection

- Place used household batteries (A, AA, AAA, C, D, 9 volt, button, NiCd, Li-ion) and cell phones together in a sealed clear bag and put on top of the closed lid to your garbage cart. Please put clear tape over both ends of each lithium and 9 volt battery and wrap cell phones in paper before placing them in the bag. Our driver will collect the bag on your regular collection day. Note that automotive batteries and any battery larger than a D cell are not accepted through this program.



Drop-Off

- Bring your household batteries to Blue Line Transfer Station. With proof of Millbrae residency, there is no charge for up to 1-gallon of batteries per business day. Blue Line also accepts automotive batteries (two per day for no charge) and items that contain non-removable batteries (for a fee).

- Bring your household batteries to one of San Mateo County's free Household Hazardous Waste collection sites/events. An appointment is required. Visit www.smchealth.org/hhw for more information.
- Bring your household batteries to a retailer-provided collection spot. To find one near you, use the search tool at www.recyclestuff.org. You'll find some Lowe's and Home Depot locations listed.

Your efforts to sort waste correctly and dispose of it safely make a difference and are appreciated!

Too Many Yard Trimmings?

We will collect overflow yard trimmings for no additional charge on your regular service day. Please notify our office at least one business day prior to your service day. Overflow yard trimmings must be contained in paper bags, boxes, or reusable can(s) and set next to your **Organics** cart. Please do not use plastic bags.



Important Reminder

Traditional and bio/compostable plastic bags prevent food from breaking down in our anaerobic digester and contaminate finished compost. They can also become tangled in our recycling sort lines. Please do not use traditional or bio/compostable bags in your green or blue carts, including liner bags. Paper bags may be used to collect food scraps if desired.
