## RECYCLING YOUR TREE!

- Remove the stand and ALL decorations including lights and tinsel
- Cut tree in half if it is over 6ft
- Place your tree at the curb by 5 am on your regular collection day
- DO NOT bag your tree

A special truck may be used to collect trees in your neighborhood. This truck can arrive earlier or later than our regular collection trucks. Flocked and artificial trees cannot be recycled and will be collected by the regular garbage route.

## YOUR CHRISTMAS TREE IS NOT JUST DECORATION

When the holidays are over, natural Christmas trees don't go to waste—they get recycled into mulch and wood chips! That means your tree can help nourish gardens, parks, and landscapes long after the lights come down.



## SEASONAL OVERFLOW!

Please do not overload any of your carts. Make sure the lids fully close and materials are not too tightly wedged inside. This will help prevent litter and ensure your carts are completely emptied. If you have overflow, follow the instructions below.

### EXTRA GARBAGE?

If your cart is full, overflow garbage can be placed in a bag next to your cart for collection on your regular service day (fees may apply). Please call us at 650.589.4020 at least one business day in advance. You may use your On-Call Cleanup service or pay a small extra bag fee.

### EXTRA RECYCLING?

If your recycling cart is full, we'll gladly pick up the extras at no additional charge. Follow these simple steps:

- Place clean, dry paper and empty recyclable containers in separate paper bags. Plastic bags are not accepted.
- Clearly label each paper bag and set next to your blue recycling cart on your regular collection day.
- Flatten and bundle cardboard boxes, and place them beside your blue cart.

## QUICK TIP: COOKING OIL
