Service Menu

GARBAGE collection containers of the following types and sizes are available:

- Cart: 32, 64 or 96 gallon
- Bin: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 cubic yard



RECYCLABLES collection containers of the following types and sizes are available:

- Cart: 96 gallon
- Bin: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 cubic yard

*Tip: Paper, recyclable containers, and cardboard are collected separately. You will need a **Recyclables** cart or bin for each.*

You need three!



ORGANICS collection containers of the following types and sizes are available:

- Cart: 32 or 64 gallon
- Bin: 1, 2, 3 or 4 cubic yard

*Tip: Yard trimmings, food scraps, and food-soiled paper can be mixed together in your **Organics** cart or bin.*



Businesses that generate more waste than can be efficiently collected via carts/bins may arrange for service using roll-off boxes or compactors.

All collection services can be provided up to five days per week (Monday-Friday). Garbage collection is also available on Saturdays for any business requiring service six days per week.

Garbage and organics service must be provided at least once per week.

Service Fees

Garbage and organics collection service are provided at a charge. Visit our website or call our office for current rates. Properly sorted recyclables are collected at no charge from those paying for an appropriate level of weekly garbage service.

Restrictions Apply

- ! Heavy material like dirt, rock, concrete, sod, brick, tile and similar cannot be collected via cart or bin. Please request a 7 cubic yard roll-off box.
- ! Yard trimmings may be collected via organics cart, bin or roll-off box. Branches and stumps that are over 6” in diameter or 3’ in length must be cut down.
- ! Electronic waste requires special handling. Please contact us for assistance.
- ! Auto parts, tires, batteries, flammables, chemicals, paint, pressure-treated wood, sharps, fluorescent lamps and other hazardous wastes are **not** allowed inside any collection container. Collection Day Checklist

- ✓ Maintain a safe and litter-free collection area. Put all garbage and recycling inside the appropriate collection bin. Keep lids closed and the ground swept.
- ✓ Confirm proper sorting. If materials have been misplaced, take corrective action.
- ✓ Do not block access to the collection area. If our driver must make a return trip, additional fees may apply.
- ✓ Contact us for help with overflow, electronic waste, or large items.

Recycling Tips

- Cardboard boxes must be dry and flat for recycling.
- Food-soiled and wax-coated boxes cannot be recycled, but they can be composted. They belong in an organics collection bin.
- Empty food and beverage containers must be scraped and rinsed for recycling.
- Shredded paper must be contained in a paper bag for recycling.
- Recyclables should be placed directly into the appropriate collection bin. Do not use liner bags.
- Styrofoam and polystyrene as well as plastic bags, wrap, straws, and utensils are not recyclable and belong in the garbage.



Recycling is Mandatory

State legislation requires that businesses implement and maintain programs to keep recyclables and organics out of landfills. Please visit www.CalRecycle.ca.gov for information on applicable legislation including but not limited to Assembly Bills 341 and 1826, and Senate Bill 1383.

Available Assistance

Upon request, our outreach team will provide training assistance to your staff or tenants. We will assess your waste generation and make suggestions to help you reduce waste, increase recycling, and comply with local and State mandates.

Proper sorting of waste is critical. Sort smart to avoid service delays and extra fees. Contact us if you have questions.

Container Maintenance

Your garbage, recyclables and organics collection bins are designed to withstand years of service. It is your responsibility to keep them relatively clean but it is our responsibility to repair or replace them as needed. If your collection container leaks, has a broken or missing lid or wheel, or is no longer properly labeled, please contact us. You can also request a steam clean; charges may apply.

Illegal Dumping & Scavenging

Reduce illegal dumping and scavenging by keeping collection bins inside a locked enclosure or by locking individual bins. Purchase your own combination lock(s) and provide us with the combination. Or, buy one of our locks. Contact us to make arrangements.
