THANK YOU FOR SORTING YOUR WASTE!



Thank you for taking the time to sort your materials correctly. Proper sorting serves an important purpose and plays a vital role in the success of our recycling and organics programs.

Keeping plastics and other contaminants out of organics helps us produce renewable natural gas from food scraps and yard trimmings while also giving our composter high-quality digestate that can be turned into compost used by farmers and landscapers throughout California.

Properly sorted recycling is equally important. At our processing facility, Blue Line Transfer, recyclable materials are separated using advanced technology, including optical sorters, eddy current, ballistic separators, and the expertise of trained employees. When recyclables are placed in the correct container and kept free of contamination, these systems can operate more efficiently and recover more valuable materials for recycling.

WHERE YOUR ORGANICS GO

When you place food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard trimmings in your green organics container, you're helping create renewable energy.



At South San Francisco Scavenger's Anaerobic Digestion Facility, organic materials are transformed into renewable natural gas (RNG), which helps fuel our collection fleet. Once the digestion process is complete, the remaining material, called digestate, is transported to a composting facility where it finishes the composting process and is turned

into nutrient-rich compost used on farms and agricultural lands. Keeping plastics and other contaminants out of the green bin is essential. Plastic contamination can interfere with processing and reduce the quality of the compost produced. By sorting correctly, you help create clean renewable fuel and high-quality compost that benefits local agriculture.

SB 1383 LID FLIPPING

Have you ever noticed someone in a yellow safety vest checking your waste containers? That's us conducting

a bin audit. California's SB 1383 requires businesses and residents to properly separate garbage, recycling, and organics. As part of this state requirement, we perform periodic inspections to identify contamination and help improve sorting practices. If you receive a tag on your container, don't worry, it's simply an educational tool designed to highlight opportunities for improvement. Our goal is not to penalize, but to provide guidance and help everyone recycle and compost more effectively.
